HISTORICAL IMPORTANCE OF 1833 LIBERATION THE TOWN ALEKSINAC

Aleksinac with its surrounding was attached to Serbian Principality 1833. By liberation Aleksinac from Turkish regime, conditions for political, economic and cultural development were made. During the period after liberation, Aleksinac as border place had custom station and quarantine, and began to accelerate the development of total public and private life. Intensive development, which started during the first rule of prince Milos, was continued to Serbian-Turkish wars 1876 – 1878.

After 1878 Aleksinac was not border place anymore and its function took over Vranje in the south, Pirot in the east and Prokuplje in the west. Therefore its importance decreased and its intensive development was stopped.
