In the study known as Floor Mosaic in Nea Phaphos built in 324 A.D., the author tries to identify members of Constantine's family: mother Helen, step mother Theodora, niece Constantia, father Constantines I Chlorus, son Constance, Constantine I the Great himself, daughter-in-law Helen the Younger, son Crisp and wife Fausta, by identifying them with characters of Hesoid's Theogonia: Nis, Anatrophous, Tropheus, Dionis, Hermes, Nectarus and Theogonia.
