Summary

TEACHER ISSUE

At the end of the XIX and at the beginning of the XX century, Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Serbian Consulate in Pristina considered teachers issue. The issue was related with problems came out from conflict between metropolitan Nicifor Petric and Serbian teachers from Old Serbia. Instead of making an effort in national-propagandistic work, Serbian metropolitan and teachers from Rasko-Prizrenian eparchy almost completely paralyzed work of schools in Old Serbia. At first, Serbian consuls were only observers of the conflict.

When the conflict gained in intensity, by the intervention of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Serbian Consulate in Tzarigrad, pressure was exerting on both sides and relations became normalized.
