## NOTES BY STEVAN DIMITRIJEVIĆ ON THE ARRIVAL OF THE BULLGARIANS IN PRIZRED IN 1915

The paper discusses the arrival of the Bulgarians to Prizren and its occupation in November 1915. The central attention is focused on Stevan M. Dimitrijević, the rector of Prizren's theology, and one of the greatest national and spiritual workers of the Serbian people at that time. He did not withdraw from Prizren with the people or the army. Instead, he remained in the Seminary to take care of the disciples and to try to preserve one of the most important institutions of the Serbian people on the territory of Old Serbia. From Stevan Dimitrijević's letters we reveal the inner grandeur and strength of his personality: he put the interests of the Serbian people before his own and stayed to share the fate of the subjugated population. The withdrawal from the enemy was considered a betrayal to his call and the state.
