The Syllabi and Curricula for Elementary Schools in the Monarchy of Serbia

In elementary school teaching, when it was limited to teaching reading and there was only one subject, the books were the only teaching aids. After the first School Law in 1844, when elementary school teaching included not only reading, writing and calculus but also certain sciences, such as history, geography and other natural sciences, other teaching aids were introduced as well. Among them there were history pictures and maps, atlas and geography maps, abacus, and some spelling and writing aids, as well as those used for drawing.
