HISTORICAL OVERVIEW OF THE TRANSFORMATION OF THE WORLD ORDER AND REFLECTIONS ON THE BALKANS

Summary: The transformation of the world order brought with it changes whose outlines we can see in the period of the bipolar, unipolar and multipolar world order. The question that arises in this paper is what will be the impact on (foreign, domestic and security policy) and the processes of the states in the Balkans.
