**A CONTRIBUTION TO THE ECONOMIC HISTORY OF SERBIA: THE TOWN
OF ALEKSINAC AND THE ALEKSINAC DISTRICT IN THE DOCUMENTS
OF THE BELGRADE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, 1923–1947**

Summary: The Historical Archives of Belgrade preserve documents created between 1910 and 1947/48 within the operations of the Belgrade Chamber of Commerce. This material represents a primary source of economic data that provides reliable testimony about the Serbian economy in the given period. This paper focuses on a specific part of the Niš District (Morava Banovina): the small town of Aleksinac in the Aleksinac District. It presents an inventory of the documents of the Belgrade Chamber of Commerce related to the work of the Aleksinac Traders' Association and the Aleksinac District from 1923 to 1948. As the economic history of Serbia during the period of the Kingdom of Serbs, Croats and Slovenes, later the Kingdom of Yugoslavia, as well as the SFR Yugoslavia, has not been sufficiently studied, the aim of this paper is to draw the attention of the scholarly and professional community—particularly master's and doctoral students of economics—to the existence of this valuable archival collection for the study of Serbia's economic history.
