THE UNVEILING OF THE MONUMENT IN HONOR OF THE LIBERATORS OF NIŠ IN THE TOWN'S CENTRAL SQUARE OF KING MILAN

One of the symbols of the city of Niš is the monument erected in honor of the liberators of Niš in 1937, for the celebration of the 60th anniversary of the liberation of Niš from the Turks. The celebration lasted for two days. On the second day, on Vidovdan, the monument was ceremoniously unveiled by Prince Paul Karađorđević. The cover fell from the monument at exactly 11:20. Three squadrons circled the sky and one of them released a wreath onto the monument. All eyes were turned to it, and it seemed grand and beautiful. Antun Avgustinčić, a sculptor from Zagreb had come up with the idea for the monument, which depicts the most important details from our past and the struggle for freedom after centuries of servitude. The celebraion lasted until midnight and ended with a magnificent fireworks display.
