Summary

THE HISTORY AND DEVELOPMENT OF THE TEACHERS' ASSOCIATION OF NIŠ, 1895-1956

The Niš proceedings of the Teachers' Association first appeared in 1887. In 1896, the Teachers' Association of Niš and the surrounding area is founded. A pause in its functioning ensued. The pause lasted from 1914 to 1919. In 1923, the project to erect the Teachers' House in Niš was initiated, which was completed in 1933. Until 1940/41 the Teachers' Association of Niš was known as the Yugoslav Teachers' Association – the Association Department for the District of Niš – Niš. After the liberation of the country, Local Syndicate Councils were formed in 1945. A change in name into the District Educators' Council of Niš happened in 1947, so that teachers were organized through the Yugoslav Educators' Syndicate – the District Council of Niš in the period from 1945 to 1952. In 1952 at the council meeting of the association, the Association of the Teachers of the City of Niš and the Teachers' Association of the Niš District were founded. The Teachers' Association of Niš gradually ceased to exist from 1955 to 31.03.1956.
