

Summary

The priest Stevan Dimitrijević (1866-1953)

The study is devoted to the 140th anniversary of the birth of the priest Stevan Dimitrijević, who has been, in the course of history, put in the order of great names who gave a great contribution to the work of Serbian church and state, Serbian culture and science. Rector of a well-known theological teacher-training school in Prizren (1899-1903; 1910-1920), the founder and the first dean of Orthodox Theological College in Belgrade, the teacher of the bishop Nikolaj Velimirović, the teacher of the four patriarchs : Varnava, Gavriilo Dožić, German and Pavle. The priest Steva is the first honorary Doctor of theological Studies of the University of Belgrade (1936). By a decree of the King of Greece in 1937, he was announced the honorary Doctor of the University of Athens. The priest Stevan Dimitrijević is also a recipient of numerous tributes and decorations for his scientific and patriotic work.
