## Summary

## The priest Stevan Dimitrijević (1866-1953)

The study is devoted to the 140<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the birth of the priest Stevan Dimitrijević, who has been, in the course of history, put in the order of great names who gave a great contribution to the work of Serbian church and state, Serbian culture and science. Rector of a well-known theological teacher-training school in Prizren (1899-1903; 1910-1920), the founder and the first dean of Orthodox Theological College in Belgrade, the teacher of the bishop Nikolaj Velimirović, the teacher of the four patriarchs: Varnava, Gavrilo Dožić, German and Pavle. The priest Steva is the first honorary Doctor of theological Studies of the University of Belgrade (1936). By a decree of the King of Greece in 1937, he was announced the honorary Doctor of the University of Athens. The priest Stevan Dimitrijević is also a recipient of numerous tributes and decorations for his scientific and patriotic work.
