The role of Deligrad in stopping the Turkish offensive in 1806

Establishing the war plans for the year of 1806, the rebels wanted to move the battles out of the borders of Belgrade pashadom, with the aim to spread the rebellion to other Serbian regions, for it was a pre-condition for a complete independence. The rebellious offensive did not bring the desired results, but the victory on Mišar and Deligrad, the conditions for further successful fighting were created, because the clashes in 1806 demonstrated all the power of the rebels and the weakness of Porta.
