Summary

The first Serbian infantry regiment in the operation of the liberation of Niš in 1918

After the breakthrought of The Front of Solun, The First Serbian Army advanced toward Nish. Despite pesimism of The Allied Supreme Command, the army liberated the town on October 12. The First Infantry Regiment of "Knjaz Milosh" stood out in the battles fought for the liberation of Nish, being the prominent unit of The First Army which successfully advanced and entered the town first. The battles of The First Infantry Regiment are obvious example of making and providing breach into depth of the oponent front. The regiment and its commanding lieutenant colonel Stojan Nikolic were praised for the action in this operation by the commander of The First Army and a commander of The Allied Forces on The South Front.
