**Ideological Background of the Agrarian Policy in the Occupied Serbia

In numerous speeches, addressing Serbian farmers as the Prime Minister of the Government of National Salvation in Serbia (1941-1943), the general Milan Nedić especially appealed to the farmers. Seeing them as major food producers, he insisted on their staying attached to their land as the ancestors of the traditionally most beautiful and most noble profession, which was in the opposition of the new national-socialistic doctrine of agrarian reform in Serbia.
