Summary

History and Work of the Aero-club of Niš

The aero-club of Nis was founded in 1927, at the initiative of the active officers, officers reservists and the youth of Nis. It stoped its work during the Second World War. In 1947, it started working again as a branch of the National Technology. This club was registered at the Air Union of Serbia every year. It was a social organization and its work was aimed at the aero-technical education of its members. The activities performed in the club were: the training of aero-modelists, parachutists, glider pilots and engine pilots. These branch trainings were managed by the Aero-club management with their professional personnel. The work of aero-club was controlled by the Army of the Yugoslavia, the Army of Serbia and the Management of the Civil Air Union, according to the existing regulations, laws and Decrees of the civil air traffic. The club was under the immediate control of the Main Committee of the Civil Air Union. The aero-club achieved remarkable results, and its members were granted a number of recognitions at the state and international competitions.
